Your sales receipt showing the date of purchase of the product is your proof of purchase. Keep it in a safe place for future reference. This warranty is subject to personal use only, commercial or rental applications will not be covered.

This product is made with the highest quality materials and is warranted to be free from defects in materials and workmanship at the time of purchase. This limited warranty applies to products manufactured or distributed by the manufacturer, are delivered in the continental United States or Canada and extends to the original purchaser, or gift recipient. This warranty becomes valid at the time of purchase and terminates either by the specified time frame listed above and/or owner transfer. Any refunds or monetary compensations must be claimed through the place of purchase (retailer), and not through the manufacturer. Any extended warranties (warranties that cover above and beyond this manufacturer warranty) that are sold through a retailer or third party, are not directly correlated with this products' limited warranty, and may be redirected to said retailer or third party for coverage.

This warranty extends through the manufacturer of the product, and covers functional parts only. Cosmetics are not covered, unless unequivocally determined it is a workmanship defect. 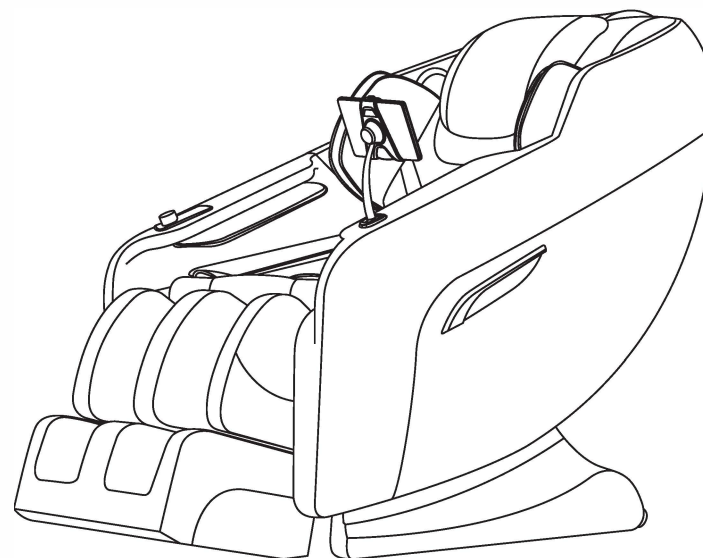

This massage chair is intended for household only. When using an electrical appliance, basic precautions should always be followed, including the following:

Read all instructions before using this massage chair.

DANGER

-To reduce the risk of electric shock:

- 1) Always unplug this appliance from the electrical outlet immediately after using and before cleaning.
- 2) Never use pins or other metallic fasteners with this appliance.
- 3) Carefully examine the covering before each use. Discard the appliance if the covering shows any sign of deterioration, such as checking, blistering, or cracking.
- 4) Keep Dry - Do not operate in a wet or moist condition.

WARNING

-To reduce the risk of burns, fire, electric shock, or injury to persons:

- 1) An appliance should never be left unattended when plugged in. Unplug from outlet when not in use, and before putting on or taking off parts.
- 2) Do not operate under blanket or pillow. Excessive heating can occur and cause fire, electric shock, or injury to persons.

- 21) This appliance is not intended for use by persons (including children) with reduced physical, sensory or mental capabilities, or lack of experience and knowledge, unless they have been given supervision or instruction concerning use of the appliance by a person responsible for their safety.
- 22) If it is not in use for a long time or after use, please turn off the power and pull out the power plug.

This massage chair is intended for household use only.

● Usage Environment

- Do not use the massage chair in an excessively humid or dusty environment as this may result in malfunction or electric shock.
- Do not use the massage chair in a room with a temperature of 104°F or higher.
- Do not expose the massage chair to heaters, stoves or direct sunlight.
- Place and use the massage chair on an even, non-slip floor.
- The massage chair is designed for home use and not for commercial purposes.

Caution

- The massage chair is to be used indoors only.
- If you use the massage chair in a cold room, do not increase the room temperature abruptly. It is recommended that you increase the temperature gradually to a normal level.
- If the massage chair is stored in a cold place and is being brought into a warm environment, it is advisable to wait one hour before use. This is because its performance may not be at optimum level, as there may be water droplets on the mechanical parts due to condensation. Using the massage chair under such conditions may result in malfunction.

IMPORTANT SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

● Safety Precautions

- To ensure safe and correct use of the massage chair, do not operate it without reading this operation manual carefully.
- Do not use the massage chair when the upholstery or seat is removed. This may cause injury or malfunction.
- Do not use the massage chair in combination with other therapeutic equipment or electric blanket, etc., as this may result in ineffectiveness or injury.
- Do not use the massage chair an hour before or after eating as this may have adverse effects on the user.
- Do not allow children or pets to play around the massage chair, e.g., behind the backrest, under the seat or leg rest of the massage chair. This may result in injury.

- Do not rest or place heavy objects on the armrests, leg rest or backrest as this may result in malfunction or injury.
- Do not use the massage chair when your body is wet.
- Do not operate the massage chair with wet hands.
It is not recommended to use the massage for more than 30 minutes.
- Do not perform continuous massage on the same spot of your body for more than 5 minutes at a time as this may result in excessive stimulation and may have adverse effects.
- Do not insert your hand or foot along the paths of the massage rollers during use as this may cause injury.
- Stop operation immediately if you experience any discomfort.
- This product is not intended for self-treatment of conditions that should be managed by a qualified health care provider.
- People on medication or with medical conditions, please consult your doctor before use.
- Please do not use the product if you are not feeling well.
- Remove all scarves, neckties, necklaces and jewelry before using the massager.

● People with Medical Conditions

Consult your doctor before use if you:

- are under medical rest as ordered by a doctor.
- have spinal disorders, an abnormal spinal condition or have suffered a spinal injury.
- have back problems.
- have diabetes, osteoporosis or sensory impairment.
- have joint dysfunction.
- have a pacemaker or other electronic medical devices.
- may be pregnant.
- have phlebitis or thrombosis.
- have an increased risk for blood clots.
- had recent surgery.
- have surgical pins, screws, or anything mechanical implanted in your body.

Safety

● Instances When the massage chair Should Not Be Used

In the following events, please switch off the main power switch immediately and disconnect the power cord from the electrical outlet:

- If water is accidentally spilled onto the massage chair. This may result in electric shock or malfunction.
- If the fabric of the backrest is torn and the internal components are exposed.
- If pain or discomfort is felt during massage, stop operation immediately and consult your doctor.
- If you detect any malfunction or any other abnormal condition during operation.
- If there is a power failure. Injury may occur when power is restored unexpectedly.
- If there is lightning.

● Assembly and Repair of the massage chair

- Do not disassemble the backrest cover of the massage chair. Touching the internal components may result in malfunction or electric shock.
- The massage chair must only be professionally serviced or repaired. Do not attempt to disassemble or repair the massage chair yourself.

● Things to Note About the Power Plug and Cord

- Check that the Alternating Current (AC) voltage corresponds with the specifications indicated for the massage chair.
- Do not connect or disconnect the power plug from the electrical outlet with wet hands. This may result in malfunction or electric shock.
- When disconnecting the power plug, pull it by holding the plug, not the cord.
- Although operation will be stopped automatically by the Auto-Timer function, always remember to switch off the main power switch after use.
- Do not place the power cord under the massage chair or any other heavy objects.
- Do not wind the power cord around the massage chair as this may damage the cord and result in a fire or electric shock.
- Do not operate the massage chair with a damaged cord or extension cord.
- Do not use the massage chair if the electrical outlet is loose.
- If the power cord is damaged, it should be replaced by a qualified technician.

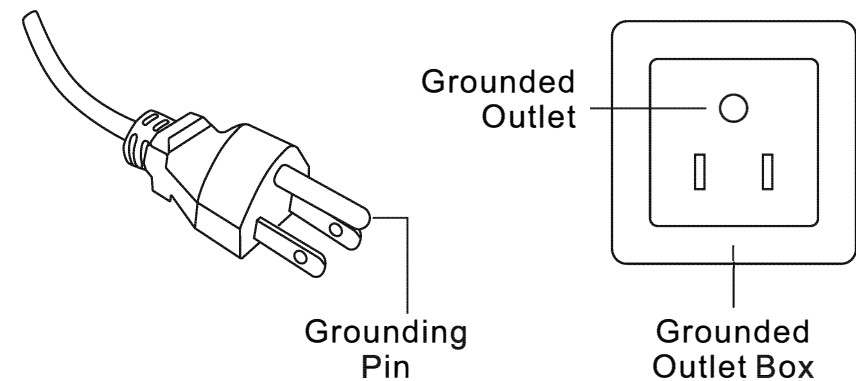
Safety

● Grounding Instructions

This product must be grounded. If it should malfunction or breakdown, grounding provides a path of least resistance for electric current to reduce the risk of electric shock. This product is equipped with a cord having an equipment-grounding conductor and a grounding plug. The plug must be plugged into an appropriate outlet that is properly installed and grounded in accordance with all local codes and ordinances.

DANGER - Improper connection of the equipment-grounding conductor can result in a risk of electric shock. 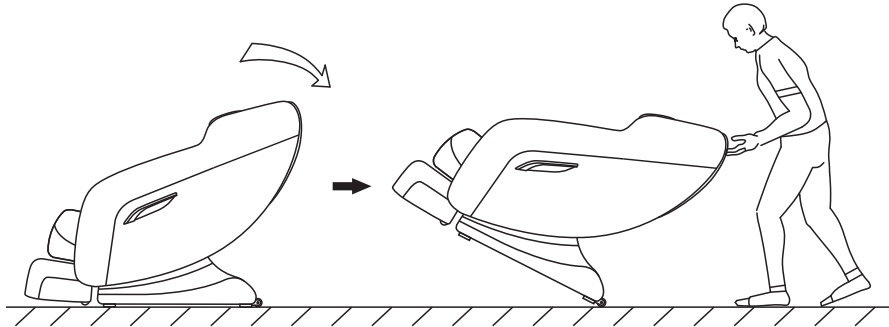

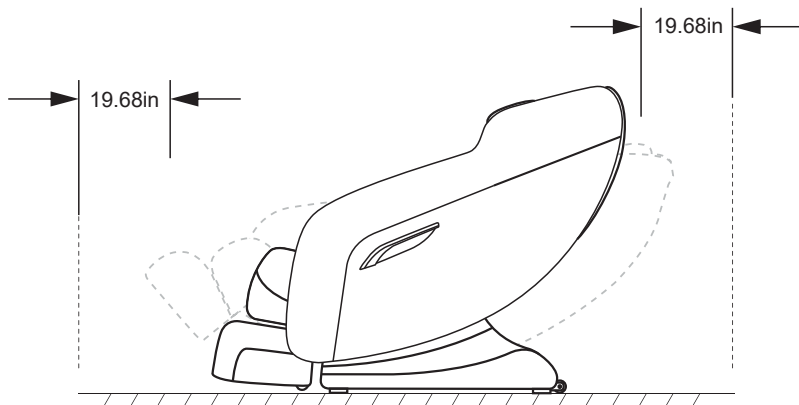
Move the Chair

- Please turn off the main power and unplug the power from the electrical outlet.
- Tilt the chair backward as shown in the picture below and wheel it to the desired location.
- Please cover the floor with mat when move the massage chair in case of any damage of floor will be made.



Place the Chair

Please make sure that there is an allowance of more than 19.68in behind the massage chair, and more than 19.68in in front of the massage chair to allow the backrest to recline without obstruction during operation.



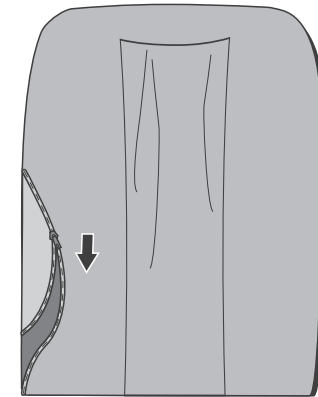
Preparation Before Use

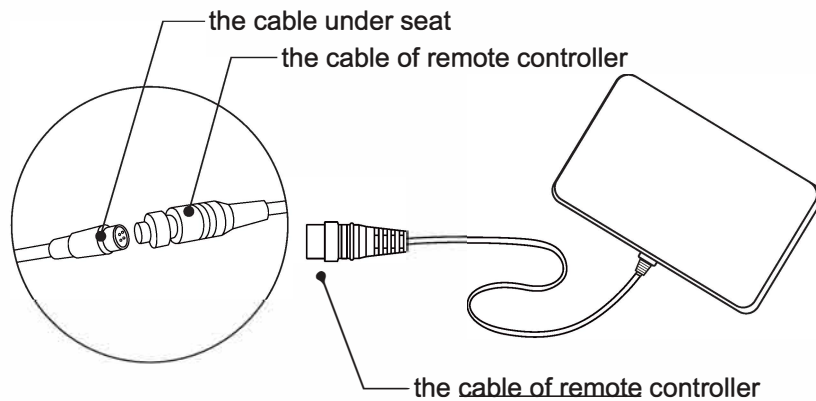
Installation of manual bracket

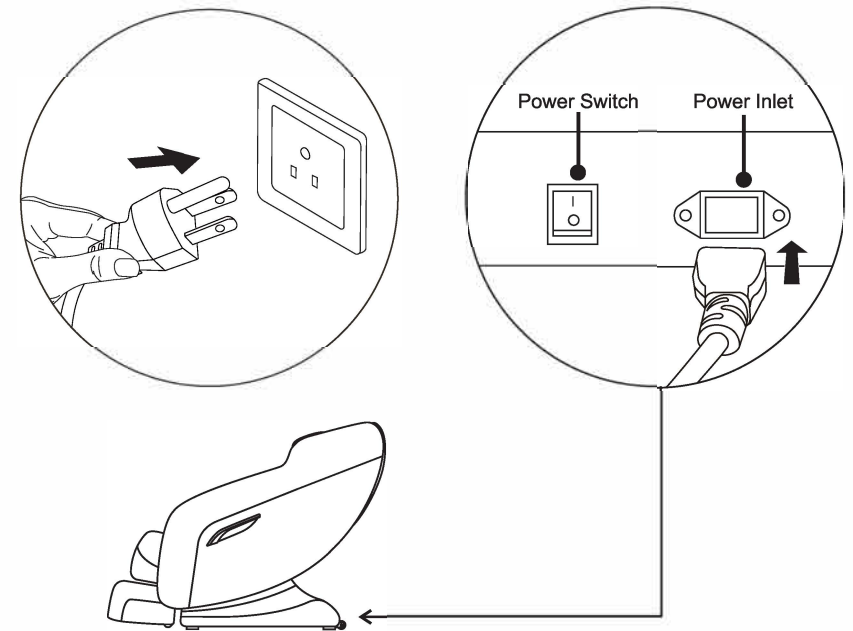
- Connect the cable of remote controller with the cable under seat.

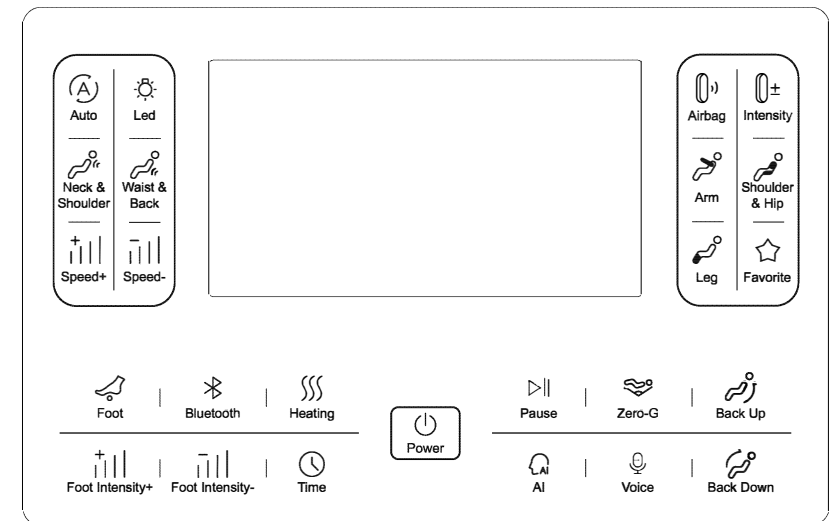
Outer Structure

Power		Once your massage chair is connected to an AC wall outlet, you can turn on the chair by power on/off key to start the massage.
Auto		Press this button to switch between multiple automatic modes. Choose the automatic mode you prefer.
Led		Press this button to turn on/off the LED light.
Neck & Shoulder		Press this button to turn on/off massage rollers on the shoulder and neck.
Waist & Back		Press this button to turn on/off massage rollers on the waist and back.
Speed+		Press this button (+) to increase the massage speed.
Speed-		Press this button (-) to increase the massage speed.
Airbag		Press this button to turn on or off the airbag massage function.
Intensity		Press repeatedly to adjust the airbag massage intensity from levels 1 to 3.
Arm		Press this button to turn on/off the arm airbags massage.
Shoulder & Hip		Press this button to turn on/off the shoulder & Hip airbags massage.
Leg		Press this button to turn on/off the leg airbags massage.
Favorite		While a massage program is being performed, hold this button for 3 seconds to record this program to your favorite program, then you can short press this button to start this program. 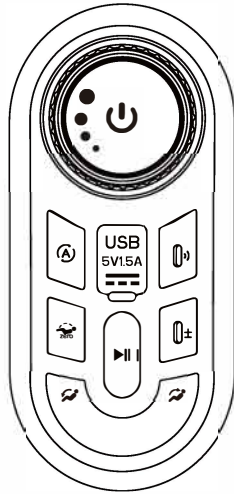

Refresh	Full body massage, the intensity of the roller and airbags is strong.
Relax	Full body massage, the massage intensity of the roller and airbags is medium.
Yoga	Full body massage, this massage simulates a Yoga exercise.
Neck & Shoulder	Partial massage: the focus is on improving neck pain and shoulder muscle strain. The massage is more focused on the neck and shoulder.
Waist & Back	Partial massage: the focus is on the waist and back to improve back pain.
Dream	Full body massage, the intensity of the rollers is light.

Cleaning and Maintenance

1. Storing the massage Chair

- With a dry, soft, clean cloth after use.
- Keep the massage chair clean and away from places of high humidity.
- If the massage is not to be used for a long period of time, cover the massage chair with dust cover and unplug its power plug from the electrical outlet.

Caution

- Do not store the massage chair in direct sunlight or in places of high temperature. This may cause the color of the upholstery to fade.
- Do not allow the massage chair remain in contact with vinyl or wallpaper for extended periods of time as this could lead to discoloration.

2. Cleaning the Massage Chair

- Before cleaning, ensure that the main power switch is off and the power plug is disconnected from the electrical outlet.
- Wipe off dust and dirt from the massage with a dry, soft, clean cloth after each use.
- This product can be cleaned thoroughly with a slightly damp cloth.
- Do not iron the upholstery.
- Do not wash the upholstery using a home washing machine as this may result in deterioration of the upholstery's quality.

Caution

- Do not use abrasive cleaning agents like benzene or thinner to the massage chair. This may cause the upholstery to fade.

3. Cleaning the Controller

- Use only a clean, dry cloth to clean the controller.

Caution

- Do not use a wet cloth to clean the controller, This may result in malfunction.

Troubleshoot

If there is still an abnormality after the following checks, to prevent any accident, please stop using the massage chair immediately. Please unplug the power cord from the outlet and contact with the dealer or the nearby customer service center.

It will automatically cool down to resume its normal condition. Please turn OFF the power and allow the chair to cool down for 30 to 50minutes.
During operation, both the controller and the Massage Chair are not working.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • If the set-time in the Timer is complete, please press the timer function again to resume operation. • Switch OFF power, and switch ON again to activate the Chair.
